Slot machines

Some general information for those who face a slot machine for the first time:

First step

You can play slots with a value ticket, which can be purchased at the cashier (with cash).

Which buttons do I press?

Selection of bet value or credit value Choose a slot that offers the bet value that suits you best. Many slot machines offer several bet values (multideno), so choose the appropriate denomination before starting to play.

Selection of paylines

Select the number of paylines you wish to play. A payline is a line in which a payout will be awarded based on the winning combination.

A winning combination is a combination of symbols that represent a certain win. Winning combinations are displayed in the pay table depicted on the slot machine.



Bet one credit or play max credit

With these two buttons you set the amount you wish to bet. Press bet one credit as many times as the number of credits you wish to play. If you select play max credit, this means that you wish to place the maximum allowed bet.

Some slots offer the option easy bet. This is usually a bet that covers all paylines with one credit.

What comes next?

Press play or spin reel (you can pull the handle) ... and now you are playing.

The slot machine spins the reels randomly and displays the outcome.

Winning combinations are displayed in the payline. The slot also indicates the amount you won. Payout amounts are always indicated in the slot machine *pay table*.

What to do?

You can decide to have your win paid out. You do so by pressing *cash out* or *pay out*. You can invest the win also in a new game.

The majority of slots offer you to possibility to select yourself the amount you wish to invest in the game. This means that it is you who decides the credit value or how much you wish to invest in the game.

Slot machine types:

Reel slots

These are the traditional type of slots. The ones you can see in old American movies.

Video slots

These are more modern slots with a touch screen. You can select the commands by touching the screen.

Multigame slot machines

These slot machines offer several games. Every time you first have a list of games you can choose form.

Multiline slot machines

These slots enable you to choose your preferred number of paylines (horizontal, diagonal, zigzag, etc.).

Multideno slot machines

These slot machines offer you to choose different denominations.

Video Poker slot machines

If you have played Poker before, then you know how this goes. These slots are similar to standard ones, only some commands are different. For example, instead of *spin reel* or *play* you have *deal* or *draw*. When you select this command, you will be dealt your cards and then you select which of them you wish to keep and which to discard. Press hold for the cards you wish to keep (often the slot suggests which cards you should keep). The same command is to be used, if you wish the cancel or change your selection. When you have chosen which cards you will keep, press again *deal* or *draw*. The game will be thus concluded and the slot will tell you whether you have won or not. If you need help or some advice, our inspectors will be glad to help and explain you the operation of each slot.



Electronic roulette

If you are familiar with American Roulette, then learning how to play electronic roulette will be easy peasy. You have to select the type of bet and number of chips you wish to bet. You do this by using your finger to move the symbol onto the command you wish to choose and then pressing it. Usually the types of bets or chip values are displayed in the bottom right hand corner of your screen. The number of chips you want to bet is to be set by pressing the betting field on the felt. When you have placed your bet, press start and wait to see which pocket the ball stops in.

Slot machine play-general rules

Slot machine breakdown: In case of a breakdown, all the game operations shall be nullified.

Payouts: Wait by the slot for the inspector to bring your win.

High wins: Wins that exceed \in 50,000 shall be paid in installments.

Damage to the slot machine: A guest who damages a slot machine on purpose is obliged to return the damage to the casino.

Contemporary play on several slot machines: Contemporary play on several slots is allowed only upon prior arrangement with the inspector. The latter can at his own discretion interrupt such game.

Forgotten items, credits, and unpaid wins: The casino shall not be responsible for credits, wins, and personal items left by the guests next to the slot machine. Found items can be claimed back from the security personnel, while uncollected wins, forgotten credits, and tickets are to be collected from the cashier by the end of the casino day, which is 7am. Validity of the value ticket: A playable ticket is valid 30 days from the issue date. After the expiry of this period the ticket is no longer redeemable.

Playable-only tickets: Some slot machines (these have a special label) do not return the remnant credits, so in this case you must play the entire ticket value.

The use of tickets at slot machines

In the Hit casinos you can play at the slot machines with cash or value tickets. The tickets are sold at the cashier, you can print them from the slot machine or get them awarded as a prize in a draw you participated in. They can also be collected from the Pivilege point or the cashier. You can insert the ticket into another slot machine and continue playing with the same value. Another option is to cash in the ticket at the cashier. The tickets are valid only in casinos. A ticket expires 30 days after it has been issued.

There are several ticket varieties:

CASHIER TICKET:

A value ticket to be purchased at the cashier. **Ticket value:** The ticket value is printed on the ticket itself. If the printed value does not match its actual value, you must inform the casino personnel immediately. Later complaints will not be accepted. **Solving disputes and complaints:** Solving disputes and complaints in compliance with the applicable law is the exclusive responsibility of inspectors.

PLAYABLE-ONLY TICKET:

This is a playable ticket that cannot be redeemed for cash and is to be printed at the slot machine. It represents the remnant (unused) value from your original ticket.

NC (NON-CASHABLE TICKET) + name of the prize game:

A non-cashable ticket issued at the Privilege point or cashier can be used to play only if it is inserted in the slot machine along with the Privilege card.

BUYABLE PROMO TICKET:

A non-cashable ticket, which is awarded along with other comps.

PLAYABLE PROMO TICKET:

A non-cashable ticket, which is issued at the Privilege point, at the cashier or from the slot machine. You must play the entire value of this non-cashable ticket at the slot machine. The win you get by playing with a non-cashable ticket can be paid in cash. If you wish to print a ticket at the slot machine, and you have not played the entire value of the non-cashable ticket, the slot machine will print two tickets. If the value of the printed ticket is not a multiple of the minimum credit, the slot machine will print out a ticket with the difference to the original ticket value, which is smaller than the minimum bet.

Ticket description

Type of ticket:

CASHOUT TICKET: a ticket printable at the slot machine CASHIER TICKET: a ticket to be purchased at the cashier PLAYABLE ONLY or PLAYABLE PROMO: non-cashable ticket NC >> + name of prize game <<: non-cashable ticket BUYABLE PROMO: a non-cashable ticket, which is issued along with other comps
